This document explains to the Learner how to complete the *Written Assessment Tasks*, the *Third-Party Report* requirements and specific information regarding Practical Assessments and simulations.

Each unit includes a Written Assessment Task, together with an Assessment Cover Sheet and Assessment instructions, as well as a Third-Party Report for the Workplace Supervisor to complete. The Navigating the National Quality Framework Written Assessment Task also covers knowledge evidence from a number of units of competency.

*Learner Practicum Information Guide:* Provides detailed information about the Practicum requirements and the Practicum process. It also includes forms and learning activities that may be used during the Practicum process.

**Recognition of Prior Learning Candidate Guide:** Clearly explains the RPL process and provides information and guidance to the Candidate. During this process the Candidate must clearly document the evidence that they are providing to substantiate their claim for RPL—this Guide includes forms to assist Candidate's with this requirement.
